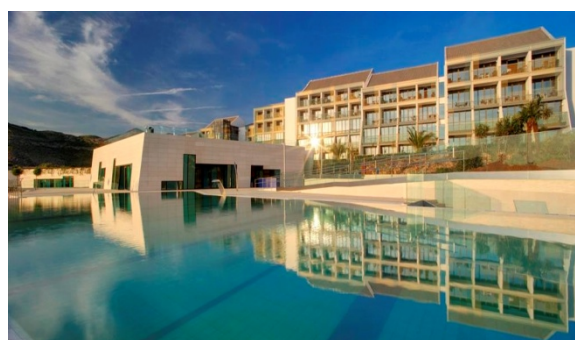
EUROPEAN TOURIST GUIDE MEETING
